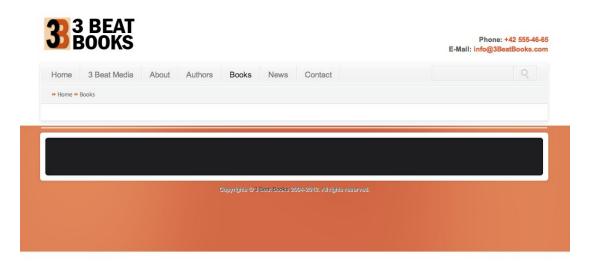
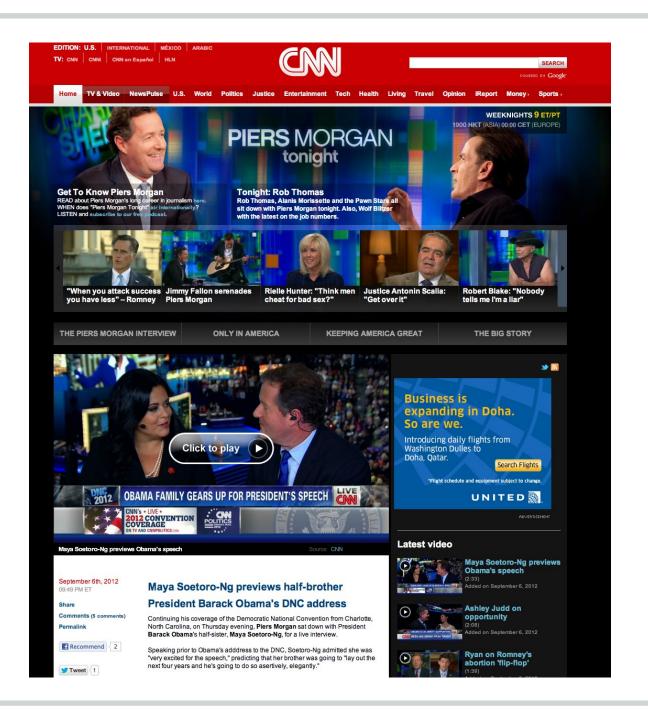

POLICE STATE: BECOMING THE HAMSTER IN THE HABITRAIL



I remember having a Habitrail and a couple of hamsters when I was a kid. It was cool because no matter where those Hamsters wandered off to (and I had quite the maze) I could watch their every move.

Suddenly we're all the hamsters in the Habitrail.

The U.S. Constitution has no express right to privacy, but the issue was brought up repeatedly in the Bill of Rights.

We don't have a right to privacy in the U.S. But the basic agreement with government has always been that the police can't just do whatever they

like, they have to have probable cause and get a warrant from the judicial branch before they start shredding privacy.

There are lots of notable exceptions, like sobriety checkpoints, that allow police to sidestep the judicial process. But generally speaking as long as you avoid driving drunk (or perhaps being an Asian American during World War II), you could have a reasonable expectation of privacy, or something like it, as an American.

Those days are long gone. Today we all carry finely tuned location tracking devices in our pockets and purses nearly all of the time.

We carry these devices voluntarily, even though we know that the government can access that location data at any time and without a warrant. And then use that data as evidence against us to convict us of crimes.

In general, we use U.S. English according to the Chicago Manual of Style, with Fowler's Modern English Usage taking over in tricky situations.

PAGE TITLES

With few exceptions, page titles are handled as follows:

Subject of page (in sentence case): Name of Magazine (initial caps)



Web design content and tutorials: A List Apart XML feeds: A List Apart

When it improves readability, we can alter the format slightly.

Consistency is important, so you'll need a good reason to make an exception.

ARTICLE TITLES, HEADLINES, AND SUBHEADS

Title case article titles (each major word is uppercase). Sentence case article headings (only the initial word is uppercase). Neither take terminal punctuation unless a question mark is required. Article titles do not take the serial comma and use the ampersand in place of "and." Article headings do take the serial comma and use the word "and."

Mark up article headings as h2 and subheads as h3 or h4 as needed. Most article headings are conceptually and rhetorically at the same level as each other; avoid unnecessary complexity and mark them up as h2 unless they're true subheads. h1 is reserved for use as a page header.

INLINE ELEMENT CASING

Inline elements should be presented in lowercase to maintain consistency with the W3C specs and improve readability.

CODE AND VAR

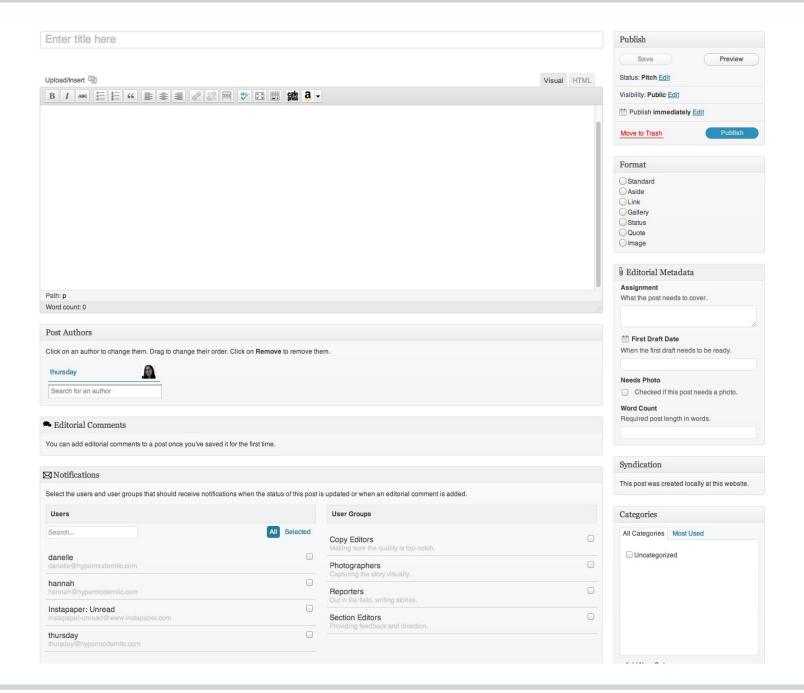
Variables and properties (see below) should be marked using the var element, while all other bits of code should be wrapped in code tags.

INLINE FUNCTION AND METHOD REFERENCES

Function and method references in paragraphs should always have their associated () unless being addressed specifically as a function or method:

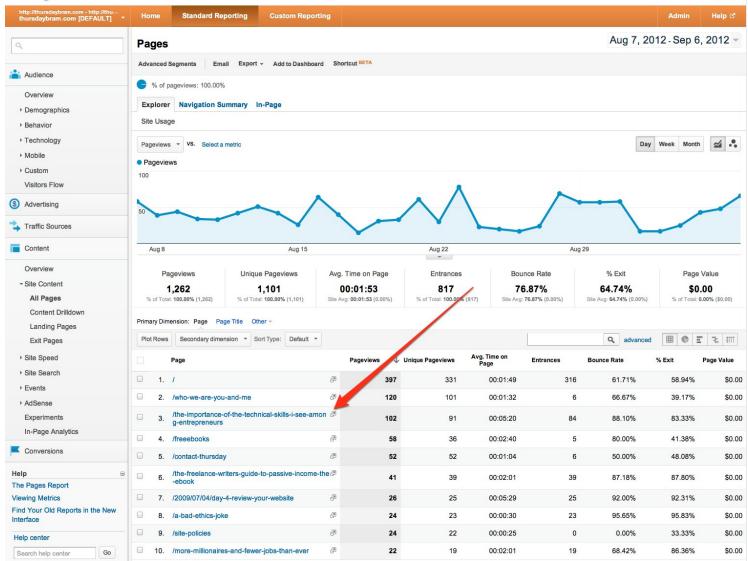

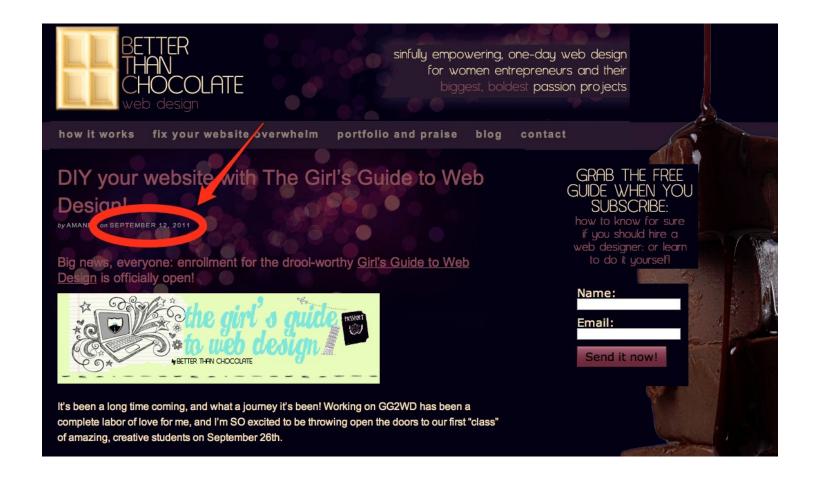

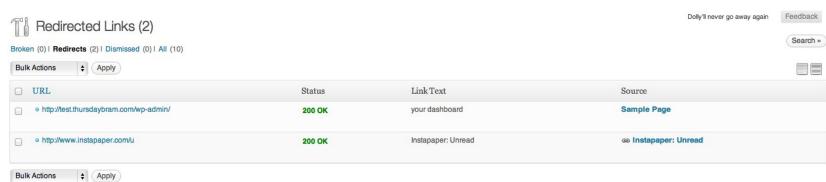
