- Common obstacles to registration:
  - Don't have an Oregon drivers' licence or state ID? Oregon does allow for registrations without an ID, but does require you to have a Social Security number – <http://sos.oregon.gov/elections/Documents/SEL500.pdf>
  - Concerned about public information? Voting records include your residential address. You can request an exemption from listing your residence address — <http://sos.oregon.gov/elections/Documents/SEL550.pdf>
  - Have difficulties completing a ballot? Any voter can request help, including in home or at care centers or libraries — <https://multco.us/elections/elections-frequently-asked-questions#14>
